The WISEST Summer Research Program places high-school students in University research settings, encouraging them to learn first-hand about research in disciplines that are less-traditional for their gender. The Networking Fair provides an opportunity for the students to meet and talk with various women and men who are working or studying in a variety of science, engineering, or technology fields.

Over the years, students have expressed that the Networking Fair is their favourite seminar as they are able to engage in discussions with Role Models about diverse careers options. In addition, past WISEST Role Models have found the discussions with students to be reenergizing and enriching as the students bring a fresh perspective. Role Models and Facilitators also have the chance to network with one other during the informal Coffee Hour.

The Networking Fair is composed of informal small group discussions, each consisting of 4-6 WISEST students, 1 facilitator, and 2-3 role models. Role Models will have a chance to speak on aspects of their career or life story, answer questions, and contribute to discussions with the students. Facilitators will assist in the flow of the discussions to ensure that students and role models have a positive experience. There will be a brief training session for Facilitators in early July.
